

SOME TIPS ON THE WAY...



- National Contact Points (NCPs) are support structures that have become an essential component in the implementation of successive Framework Programmes. They provide information and on-the ground advice to potential applicants and beneficiaries, through the project life cycle, in their own language, in a manner that would be impossible for the Commission and its Agencies acting alone.
- You need to know well the guiding principles for NCPs published by the Commission.

OUR NATIONAL CONTACT POINTS STAFF

Full-time & Part-time Professionals: Above 35 people working full-time in Madrid and some in Brussels. All HE functionalities covered, including specialties' by function

Independence in Management. No conflicts of interest arising from participation in HE projects (except networks)-Mandatory signature of letter of confidentiality with the Ministry

Great experience in international & domestic contexts: A multidisciplinary team with a good knowledge of the national R&I system and the European landscape.

Openness & Networking: Service is provided to **all** types of participating entities.

Offering support - Operational autonomy supporting specialized services: logistics, information technology, legal, personnel, etc.

WHAT DO WE DO?

<u>Providing advice</u> to participants throughout the life cycle of proposals: analysis and early detection of opportunities, guidance on the calls, proposals screening, partner search, assistance in the negotiation and implementation of financed projects.

<u>Selective Promotion</u>: Organization and participation in workshops, seminars, conferences, infodays, etc.

<u>Training</u>: Organization of specific seminars and courses. Participation in postgraduate courses and Masters. Development of guidelines for participants

<u>Active information dissemination services</u>: generation of contents for the national website, publications, guides...

Other measures: Framework Program Annual Conference, Horizon Europe online launch events in Spanish regions, Annual reception in Brussels for Spanish R&D staff

Specialization Courses: Courses aimed at <u>managers of Project Offices</u> from RPOs, universities, businesses, public administration, associations, etc.

Short-term stays in Brussels (six weeks at SOST-CDTI Office): Aimed at <u>experienced personnel</u> of organizations with special interest in the Framework Programme.

Specialized Seminars for European projects advisors

These low-cost measures have created an important community of European project managers.







EVOLUTION OF SPANISH PARTICIPATION IN FP





CONCLUSIONS



- The <u>management model</u> of the Framework Program in Spain is centralized in an almost completely decentralized country.
- However, the <u>Regions</u> (Comunidades Autónomas) also play an important role in the awareness and financing.
- The strategy pursued includes raising of awareness; training; direct support to proposers, and structures creation
- The results are very <u>positive</u> in terms of participation increase and success rate.
